Once the books are put together, the complete Bible is over a meter long. We are so blessed to be able to volunteer in this program and can't wait to see how much we can help in the next year!

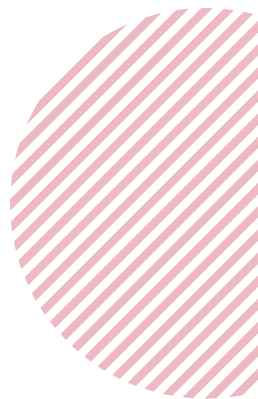
-We will be holding a sock drive in November. Stay posted for updates.
